



Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct is designed to ensure a positive, respectful, and enjoyable environment for all members of the Tustin Hills Racquet & Pickleball Club. We expect all members to adhere to these guidelines.

Good Sportsmanship

1. **Respect:** Treat all players, officials, and spectators with respect. Avoid arguments and maintain a positive attitude.
2. **Fair Play:** Play fairly and honestly. Do not cheat or take advantage of others.
3. **Encouragement:** Encourage your fellow players. Applaud good plays, regardless of which player or team made them.

Court Etiquette

4. **Walking Through Courts:** To minimize disruption, only walk through courts after a point has ended. Wait for a suitable break in play before crossing behind a court.
5. **Cleanliness:** Keep the courts clean. Dispose of trash properly and leave the court in the same condition you found it.
6. **Appropriate Language:** Use respectful and appropriate language at all times. Profanity is not permitted. While we want you to have fun, please keep the yelling and shouting to a minimum, as it can be perceived as a hindrance to play on other courts.
7. **Appropriate Attire:** Wear appropriate tennis or pickleball attire when on the court. This includes tennis shoes, shorts or skirts, and a comfortable shirt. Please note that shirtless play is not appropriate.

Guest Policy

8. **Host Responsibility:** When a member books a court, they are considered the "host". As such, each member 'host' is responsible for any guest they have invited as well as the applicable guest pass.
9. **Guest Fees and Sponsorship:** Each member is responsible for their invited guest, whether acting as "host" or not. All guests must be sponsored by a THRPC member or be a guest of the club. The member may assume the guest fee, provide a guest pass, or the guest may pay the fee at the front desk upon arrival.
10. **Guest Pass Requirement:** In the interest of maintaining a consistent guest policy, if a non-member is playing on a "hosted" court, that member will be responsible for ensuring the player obtains a guest pass, either charged to the member's account or paid by the non-member.
